Trump's move was seen as a major step towards normalization. In a phone call with Morocco's King Mohammed VI, the US president agreed to recognize Morocco's claim to the Western Sahara region, which has been at the center of a long-standing dispute with Algeria.

Algeria later rejected Trump's stance, saying the US move was "a betrayal" because it contradicts UN resolutions, especially those on Western Sahara.
