

POLISARIO Front calls on Security Council to end Morocco's intransigence and aggression which threatens peace and stability in the region

Chahid Al-Hafed, February 03, 2022 (SPS) - The Permanent Office of the National Secretariat of the POLISARIO Front called on, in its meeting held on Wednesday evening, the UN Security Council to intervene to put an end to the Moroccan expansionist and aggressive intransigence that threatens peace and stability in the region.

The Permanent Office, in its meeting chaired by the President of the Republic, Secretary-General of the Polisario Front, Brahim Ghali, affirmed that the expansionist and provocative policies of the Moroccan occupying state, and its violation of the ceasefire agreement, in full view of the United Nations, and its targeting of defenseless civilians, Sahrawis, Algerians and Mauritians, by advanced weapons of destruction. These are all developed facts that make the UN Security takes its responsibilities and intervene to put an end to this intransigence and aggression that threatens peace and stability in the entire region.

On the other hand, the meeting listened to a report on the recent visit of the Personal Envoy Staffan de Mistura to the Sahrawi refugee camps, where it was recalled the strict principled position expressed by all components of the Sahrawi people, at all levels, to cling to their inalienable and non-negotiable right to self-determination and independence.

The visit was also an occasion to recall the extent of the massive human rights violations committed by the Moroccan occupation state, such as what the fighter Sultana Khaya and her family are subjected to, and the Sahrawi civilian prisoners in Moroccan prisons.
